By choosing to lease your scooter or powered wheelchair through Motability, you will join over half a million satisfied customers who are already enjoying one of our worry-free packages. So whether it is for a trip down to the shops, to use around your home or to visit friends and family, Motability can make it easier.

Motability was set up in 1978 by the Government with all party support and since then has helped over two million people become mobile. We have been offering services to disabled people for over 30 years, by using their mobility allowance in exchange for a brand new car, scooter or powered wheelchair. There are currently over 570,000 people enjoying the benefits of Motability, so you will be in great company.

The Motability Scheme is directed and overseen by Motability, a charity that also raises funds and provides financial assistance to customers who would otherwise be unable to afford the mobility solution they need.

Motability Operations is the not-for-profit company responsible for the finance, administration and maintenance of Motability cars, scooters, and powered wheelchairs. When you lease a product through Motability, all or part of your higher rate mobility allowance is paid directly to Motability Operations for the length of the agreement. You cannot lease both a car and a scooter or powered wheelchair at the same time.



This Guide explains what leasing a scooter or powered wheelchair through Motability means, how it works, the benefits, as well as some tips to help you make the right choice for you. How Motability works and who is eligible

If you receive either of the following benefits and have at least 12 months' award remaining you can exchange some or all of this to lease either a car, scooter or powered wheelchair from Motability:

- **Higher Rate Mobility Component of the Disability Living Allowance (currently £49.85 a week) from the Department for Work and Pensions (DWP)**
- **War Pensioners' Mobility Supplement (currently £55.65 a week) from the Service Personnel and Veterans Agency (SPVA)**

Parents can apply on behalf of a child who receives the allowance, but please speak to your dealer, as some products may not be suitable for all ages.

Only the person in receipt of the allowance can use the scooter or powered wheelchair. It should not be used, for example, by your partner or spouse.

Unfortunately, the Attendance Allowance cannot be used to lease cars, scooters or powered wheelchairs through Motability.

Nothing to worry about with Motability

Motability scooters and powered wheelchairs are available on a three year Contract Hire lease (five years for some custom-built powered wheelchairs). This simply means that you lease the product from us and that the relevant amount of your allowance will be paid directly to us every four weeks, to cover the lease payments. Leaving you to enjoy freedom and independence without the worry of organising insurance and dealing with repairs or breakdowns. Hire purchase (where you buy the product in instalments) is not available.

As most scooters and powered wheelchairs through Motability cost less to lease than your weekly allowance, you will still directly receive the remainder of your allowance to spend however you choose.



The worry-free package at a glance

With Motability, you get more than just the scooter or powered wheelchair of your choice, you get all the support and help you need to enjoy worry-free mobility. In fact, our current customers rate our service so highly that **95% of them would recommend Motability to a friend.**

Everything here is included in your lease and you will find more details over the page:

- ✓ A new scooter or powered wheelchair of your choice every three years
- ✓ Standard pricing nationwide
- ✓ Over 200 products – most costing less than your weekly allowance
- ✓ Insurance from RSA Motability (RSAM) which covers any damage to people or property caused by your product

- ✓ Breakdown assistance from Motability Assist – 24 hours a day, 365 days a year
- ✓ Servicing, maintenance and repairs – call outs and home collections can be arranged with your dealer
- ✓ Replacement tyres and batteries

However, there are some things that are not included:

- ✗ Optional extras on the product that are not fitted as standard
- ✗ More than three claims for lost or stolen keys
- ✗ Any fines you may incur
- ✗ Insurance cover for theft or damage to personal belongings such as coats, bags, mobile phones and money

Other things to consider:

- Tax – the DVLA provide this free of charge for Class 3 scooters and powered wheelchairs (Class 2 products do not require tax – for more information on Class categories refer to page 11)
- You will also need somewhere secure to store your scooter or powered wheelchair overnight or when unattended

All the details

Every part of Motability has been designed to provide our customers with worry-free mobility, yet a lot of people find it hard to believe that there is no catch. There really isn't, all this is included:

A wide range to choose from

With Motability you get a brand new scooter or powered wheelchair every three years. There are over 200 products to choose from, many of which cost less than your allowance so there is bound to be one that suits your needs and budget.

Specialist dealers will help you

We work with a nationwide network of dealers to ensure that no matter where you live in the UK there are people who can visit you to discuss the products available, as well as provide servicing, maintenance and repairs throughout your lease. All our dealers have attended specialist training and are continually updated to ensure they know about all aspects of Motability. Please feel free to ask them any questions relating to your choice of product or your Motability lease.

Tyres and breakdown assistance

There is no need to worry about punctures or damage to your tyres as they are always repaired or replaced whenever there is a problem. If you are out and about when you get a puncture preventing you from being able to get home safely, our partners at Motability Assist will help get you, and your scooter or powered wheelchair home.

You can also take your scooter or powered wheelchair abroad to use, but it is worth noting that it will not be covered by breakdown assistance, and certain insurance restrictions apply.

Insurance

Insurance is important in case of an accident, damage or theft of the product. With Motability, you are covered in these instances, with no excess to pay. The insurance also covers you against any damage caused by your scooter or powered wheelchair to other products, property or people.

Batteries

Your scooter will come with a battery as standard so all you have to do is remember to keep it charged. If anything goes wrong with the battery through normal every day use, it will be replaced, free of charge.

Modifications

The majority of scooters and many powered wheelchairs come as standard from the manufacturer (except in cases of custom-built powered wheelchairs).

All our scooters will come with a weatherproof cover as standard, so you can get out and about whatever the weather! For additional adaptations speak to your dealer to discuss prices and details.



Which one is right for you?

To get the most out of your scooter or powered wheelchair you will need to choose one that matches your needs and lifestyle. With many different sizes and models to choose from we have listed a few things to consider to help you in your choice.



You may already know whether a scooter or powered wheelchair is right for you, but if you are not sure here is a quick guide.

A **scooter** is probably the right choice if you can travel relatively

independently, get on and off the scooter on your own, and are likely to need it for trips to the local shops, or to visit family and friends.

A **powered wheelchair** may be the right choice if you need prolonged mobility assistance throughout the day, mobility around the home, are not able to transfer on and off seats easily or can only operate joystick controls.

Ease of getting on and off

If you have difficulty with your leg movements you will need plenty of room to get on and off the scooter in comfort. To help, some models will be fitted with a seat that swivels round at least 90°. Try getting on and off various models to see which works best for you before you decide.

Ensuring trips are comfortable

If you are going to use your product regularly, or for longer trips, think about how far it can travel on a fully charged battery and also the comfort of the seat. If you need to take it in your car, many scooters can be dismantled into parts or folded, but it is worthwhile trying this out to make sure you, or a friend or family member, know how to do this and are able to

lift the parts into and out of your car. Some powered wheelchairs cannot be dismantled or transported safely in a car, so think about how this might impact your journey.



Your typical journey

Where you intend to use your scooter or powered wheelchair, and what for, will also have a bearing on which model is most suitable for you. Factors such as the clearance, turning circle, and manoeuvrability will vary from model to model, so if you travel on smaller pavements with sharper corners, or intend to use the product around your home, you will need to bear this in mind. Also, if there are steep hills that you regularly need to travel up, you may need extra power, especially once you are carrying shopping. Your dealer will explain the options in greater detail.

Enjoying a smooth ride

It is also worth thinking about the kinds of surfaces you usually travel on, as some products come with solid tyres and others are air filled. Also consider whether a sturdier model or something a bit lighter to get you around your local supermarket or shopping centre would be better. Your dealer will go through a full assessment with you to ensure you make the right choice for your lifestyle.

Feel at ease and in control



However long your average trips are, you will want to be comfortable and feel totally in control of the scooter or powered

wheelchair. So when you test them out, check that the steering column or 'tiller' is in easy reach and if not, ask the dealer if it can be adjusted. On all models, the controls themselves are usually very simple, and can be operated even if you have limited strength in your hands.

Remember to recharge it

As your product is battery powered you will need to be able to plug it in wherever you store it. When our dealers come to your home to carry out an assessment they will advise you on a solution that might be suitable for you, particularly if you need to store it outside.

Optional extras

Your scooter will automatically be provided with a weatherproof cover, and many of the models also come with a storage basket. There are also many other accessories available at extra cost including storage units, ramps, crutch and cup holders. Your dealer will be able to advise you on whether any additional accessories would be beneficial for your needs.

Custom-built

Most powered wheelchairs come in a standard design but in some cases your disability might require you to have your powered wheelchair custom-built. If you believe this to be the case, please contact your nearest specialist dealer – you will find their details on our website.

What's next

If you are interested in leasing a scooter or powered wheelchair, your next step should be to contact a few Motability dealers. Talk through your needs with them and they will arrange to bring products for you to try. If you would like to see a wider range of products you can visit a dealer showroom, although not all dealers have this facility. Your dealer will also carry out a suitability assessment to make sure you are choosing a product that is right for your needs and can be stored safely at your home.

If you organise a home visit the dealer will not be able to bring all of their products, so it is important you speak to each dealer about all of your needs beforehand. Make sure you try out all the models you are interested in before deciding which one is best for you. If during your assessment the dealer



identifies a model which would be suitable for you, they will make sure you get to try this out before deciding whether you want to place an order.

Remember you will have your scooter or powered wheelchair for the next three years so make sure you get all the advice you need to pick the one that is right for you.

There are lots of sources of independent advice to help you make the most informed decision – for example, Mobility Assessment Centres, the NHS, and health professionals.

Arranging a dealer or home visit



To ensure you choose the scooter or powered wheelchair that is right for you, a specially trained dealer will be happy to come to your home with a selection of products for you to try. This is also a great opportunity to see how the scooter or powered wheelchair fits around your home and lifestyle. Alternatively you can visit a dealer showroom to see a range of models.

You can find your nearest dealer via our online 'Find a Dealer' tool at www.motability.co.uk or call **0800 953 3060**. The dealerships will often cover wide areas of the country, so even if your nearest one is quite far away they can usually visit you. We also have some dealers who operate nationally, and these will appear on your search results too.

All of our dealers are used to answering a whole range of questions, so no matter how small or simple the question is, they will be happy to help you.

We recommend that you try any scooter or powered wheelchair in the environment that you will use it regularly, before you commit, to ensure it meets your needs.

A handy checklist of considerations to discuss with your dealer:

- Your height and weight
- How far do you typically travel?
- Could your disability affect your ability to get on and off the product?
- Do you have full use of your hands for controls?
- Will you need to travel on public roads?
- Are there high kerbs to negotiate on your typical journeys?
- Are there steep hills to get up and down?
- How much shopping are you likely to carry?
- Will you need to get the product into a car?
- Is there somewhere safe to keep it at home where you can charge it?
- Will you want to use it around your home?
- Do you know which accessories you might need?
- Do you think your condition may change over the course of your lease?
- Do you have step free access into and around your home?

And for the visit itself:

- Thoroughly discuss your needs with the dealer
- Do not feel pressured to choose there and then
- Test drive each of the models the dealer brings
- Have a trusted family member or friend with you for a second opinion

Remember you can see as many dealers as you like – do not feel obliged to place an order with the first dealer who visits.

How to order

To make ordering quick and simple, it is completed through our online system at the dealership. If you are at home the dealer will take your information and place the order on your behalf.

Your allowance will be held by the Department for Work and Pensions or Veterans Agency from the date your dealer expects you to take delivery of your new scooter or powered wheelchair. If for any reason the delivery date is delayed after your allowance has been held, any monies owed will be paid back to you as soon as your new scooter or powered wheelchair is delivered.



A PIN (Personal Identification Number) will then be sent to you which you will need to enter when collecting your scooter or powered wheelchair. Alternatively, you can authorise the dealer to enter this on your behalf to confirm the start of your lease.

Upon delivery, the dealer will take you through a full demonstration of your product, including a test drive to make sure you are confident with how to use and get the most out of your product. You will also get full details of your lease and insurance cover in a handbook.

Make sure you are safe!

When out and about do not forget the Highway Code. There is a special section dedicated to scooters and powered wheelchairs (rules 36 – 46). Full details of this can be found on www.direct.gov.uk

How to use the pricing tables

DLA/WPMS Holders

The cost of each scooter or powered wheelchair may differ depending on whether you receive the Higher Rate Mobility Component (HRMC) of the Disability Living Allowance (DLA) or the War Pensioners' Mobility Supplement (WPMS). Prices are based on a three year lease agreement.

Speed in miles per hour (mph)

This is the maximum speed each model can travel at. All products capable of greater than 4mph will have controls that allow you to limit the speed to 4mph on pavements.

Product weight

The weight of the product may have an impact on your ability to transport it.

Class

Class 2 products are limited to 4mph and are suitable for pavement use only. Class 3 products are able to travel up to 8 mph and can be used on some roads.

Number of wheels

The number and dimensions of a scooter's wheels and tyres has a direct effect on its stability and ability to tackle obstacles.

Range

This is how far the product will travel on average once fully charged. This range is an estimation only and will vary by use, the type of ground, the weight carried by the product, the condition of the motor and the charge level of the battery. Make sure you take into account your return journeys.

Description

This gives you the range and model name.

Advance Payment (AP)

The non-refundable amount payable up front to your dealer in addition to your four weekly mobility allowance. The amount will depend on the product, but most scooters and powered wheelchairs do not require an Advance Payment.

Weekly rental

Shows the relevant amount of your weekly allowance (either DLA or WPMS) that each product will cost. Payments will be made directly to Motability Operations every four weeks. T/A stands for "Total Allowance" and means that the total amount of higher rate mobility allowance is payable in exchange for your product.

Weight Capacity

This is the maximum weight that the product is designed to safely carry.

We recommend that you try any scooter or powered wheelchair in the environment that you will use it regularly, before you commit, to ensure it meets your needs.

- The Contract Hire prices contained within this guide are subject to change on a quarterly basis.
- You need to have at least 12 months' award remaining to be eligible for a Motability Contract Hire lease.

SMALL – Boot scooters (Class 2, up to 4mph)



Usually dismantle into a few parts to allow you to stow it in a car boot. Make sure you try the scooter with the car you travel in most frequently to ensure it fits and that the person who needs to lift it is able to do so comfortably. They are often made with a lighter frame to make them easier to transport, but this also means they will carry less passenger weight and have a limited battery range.

MEDIUM – Midrange scooters (Class 2 and Class 3 up to 6mph)



Medium sized scooters are generally sturdier than smaller scooters, but are not as easy to fold or dismantle so may be more difficult to transport in a car (speak to dealers to find out which models you can dismantle). Class 3, 6mph scooters in this section can be used on the road if they are taxed.

LARGE – Road legal scooters (Class 3, up to 8mph)



Class 3 scooters are classified as road legal by the Department of Transport, meaning they require road tax (provided free of charge by the DVLA). They can travel up to 8mph on the road (4mph limit for pavements), and are suitable for longer distances and rougher surfaces. As they are larger, they require more space for storage and are much heavier – therefore cannot be transported in a standard car. However they are also more sturdy and generally have larger seats and can carry more weight.

- Generally have a greater battery range, so they can travel further between charging
- Complete with lights, indicators and horn
- Generally larger and require more storage space

The latest prices

Our prices are negotiated and updated every three months so that we can provide our customers with the best offers from each manufacturer. The prices listed here are for orders submitted through a Motability dealership between **1 January and 31 March 2011**. Our firm 'price guarantee' means that the price you agree with your dealer when you place the application is the price you pay, even if it changes before you collect your product.

Many of the models available cost less than your four weekly mobility allowance, which means you will get some money back. There are also some higher specification models which may require an upfront payment, or what we call an 'Advance Payment'. This covers the difference between the cost of the

product and your allowance amount over the period of your lease. Either way, you will be sure to find something that suits both your needs and budget. And with our all inclusive worry-free package everything is taken care of, so you can enjoy getting out and about.

Over the next few pages, as well as prices, you will find a summary of the basic differences between the various types of scooters and powered wheelchairs. Our dealers will be able to explain more about the differences between models.
